### The Sacraments Initial Meeting

Dear Parents/Carers,

At St Cuthbert's, children make their First Holy Communion in Year 4. Through our Religious Education lessons in school, children learn about the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Eucharist. We are beginning to prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in school and this is something the children undertake before they make their First Holy Communion (Sacrament of the Eucharist) in the Spring.

Father Mariadas would like to invite parents/carers who are interested in continuing this journey in faith to an informal meeting to find out more about the Sacraments and the commitments involved in completing them. Your child/children will be supervised by a member of school staff for the duration of the meeting. This provision will only apply for children on roll at St Cuthbert's. Once all children have been dismissed, we will invite you and your child back into the school in preparation for the meeting which will take no longer than one hour.
