Dear Parents/Carers,

Christmas Fair

In partnership with our PTFA, we will be trying out a new approach to our Christmas Fair fundraiser this year on the back of the success of our Summer Fair which everyone really enjoyed. The Christmas Fair will be held during the school day on **Friday 9th December from 2pm until 4pm**. There will be a variety of outdoor games, smaller tabletop games, a raffle and lots of other activities for the children and our families to enjoy.

Even though the Summer Fair was enjoyed by all, one issue identified by many of us was that it was just too busy. Of course, we want as many families and children to attend as possible, but we also want to ensure the experience is as enjoyable as possible. This is why we will be starting the fair at 2pm.

Any families wishing to attend from 2pm with their children would enter the school grounds as normal, collect their child and then come around to the main entrance of school to attend the fair and then leave at their leisure. Any families wishing to attend with their children from 3pm would just collect their child as normal and then go around to the main entrance to enter the fair.

Please note the following:

- Any children wishing to attend the Christmas Fair must be accompanied by their parents or carers.
- There will be stalls on offer selling sweets, juice, hot dogs, teas, coffees etc. with prices ranging from 10p to £1.
- There will also be a whole host of larger games and activities available for the children to enjoy at 50p per activity. As with the Summer Fair, we will be selling tokens worth 50p each on the day which will enable the children to participate in one of the activities. For example, one 50p token will give a child three shots on our penalty shoot-out. If the child gets one of their shots past our goalie, they will win a small prize.
- There will be raffle tickets on sale on the day. The raffle will be drawn at 3.45pm.
- The larger game activities will be on the yards and the smaller table top activities and stalls will be in the KS1 Hall.
- Food, drinks and sweets will be available to buy in the KS2 Hall.

To help support school with the raffle prizes, we will be hosting a 'Bring a prize' for the raffle Non-uniform/Own Clothes Day on Friday 25th November. Please only donate if you can. All children are welcome to join in the Non-uniform/Own Clothes Day.
