



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Catch-up Premium

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How the fund will be spent

Purchase of two online reading programmes: Reading Eggs for KS1 and reading Plus for KS2. These programmes have been purchased for the next three years

Purchase of resources and training to support social and emotional well-being (we have purchased Apple's Friends and

Purchase of technology to support pupils to access additional learning – we are currently fundraising to enable school to buy digital devices for each FSM family to use during partial or whole school closures

Purchase of 1:1 Maths Tuition via Third Space Learning for targeted children beginning in the Spring Term

How the impact of the fund on educational attainment will be assessed?

All children have been assessed in Reading and Maths and those identified as needing to catch up on lost learning in terms of academic achievements and progress made targeted for catch-up programmes. This is based on age related expectations, previous academic performance of targeted children prior to the lockdown and school closures and where there is a significant difference between a child's chronological age and their reading or Maths age.

Pupils will be assessed periodically to check that they are making up lost learning and progress and to gauge the impact of the strategies and approaches introduced.

Standardised assessments have been used in the first instance to establish a baseline and other curriculum based assessments in reading and Maths will be completed termly to allow the initiatives time to have an impact and to inform any next steps needed.
