During our topic of Good News, we have...


- Talked about what good news is and explained about a time when they've been given good news.AT: B7 Listened to the story of Pentecost. AT1:A1,AT1:A8,

We made flame headbands so we could wear them when we re-enacted the story of Pentecost. We used pom poms and streamers to shake to create the effect of the wind rushing into the room where the disciples were. When we acted out the story, we discovered that the disciples went from feeling scared and disheartened to feeling strong, brave and confident. We recognised that having heard the Good News, lots of people shared these fantastic feelings inspired by the Holy Spirit.


