

Family Club Work with parents and their children together in a safe, friendly environment where they can join in a structured activities that encourage positive family relationships. No Frills Parenting Down to earth, straight talking parenting tips and tools to support positive parenting.	Parents/carers who need support around behaviour or to gain more confidence in their parenting skills. Creche dependent on need	3 weekly Sessions
Women's Wellbeing To improve the emotional, heath and wellbeing through use of creative activities to build self-confidence and self-esteem. Decider (Young People) The Decider Skills use CBT and DBT (cognitive and dialectical behaviour therapy) skills to teach children, young people to recognise and manage thoughts, feelings, and behaviour.
