We drew pictures of our families and labelled them. We know that our families are very special.

We discussed what happens when a baby is baptised and learnt some of the words from the rite. AT1:A10, AT1:A13, AT1:A14, AT1:B2





We learned about the font, the candle, the special clothes and the role of the priest, parents and Godparents. We role played baptism and said the words, "I Baptise you in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

We looked at pictures and items to do with Baptism. We made Baptism cards. We used words such as 'font' and 'Godparents' when we role played Baptism. We sent in photos of when we were baptised and showed them to the rest of the class. We talked about who are Godparents were and what happened at our Baptisms.
